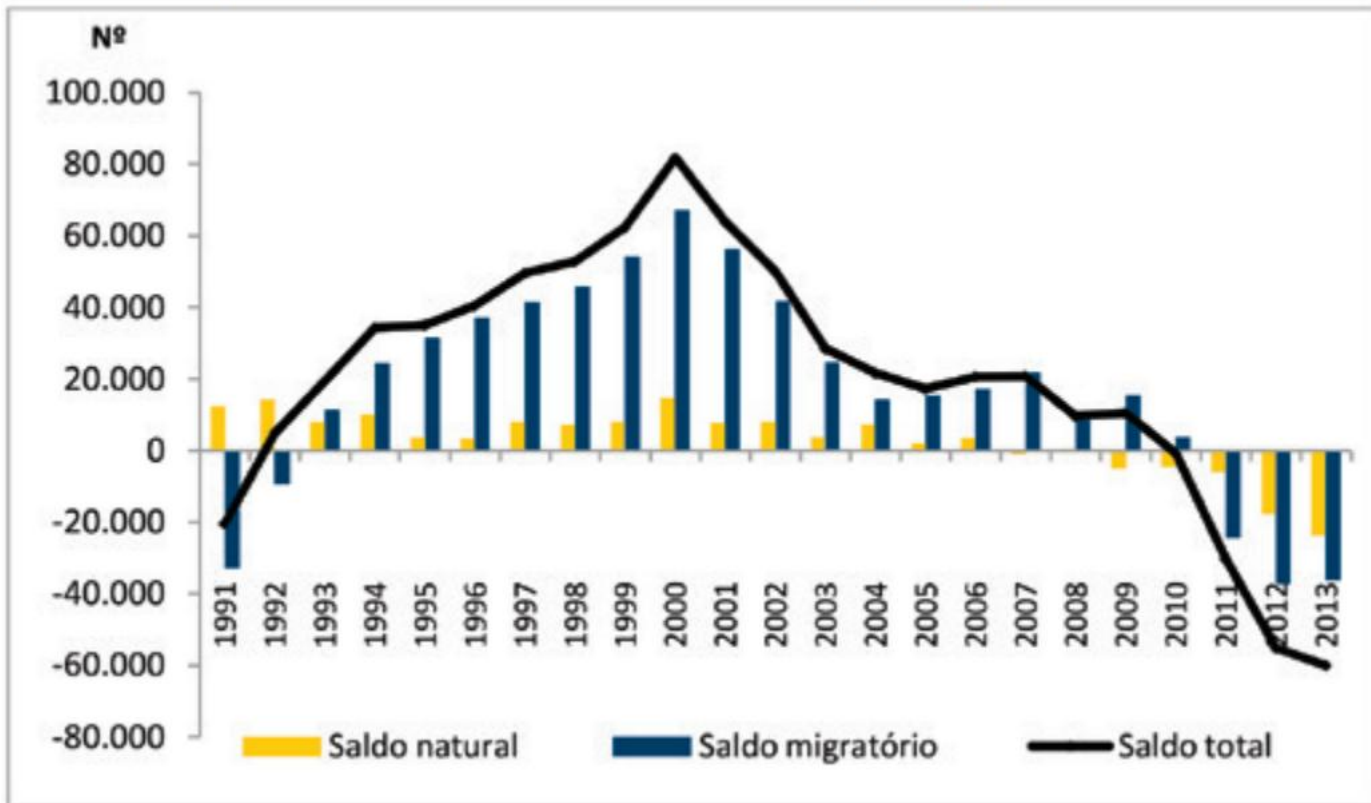

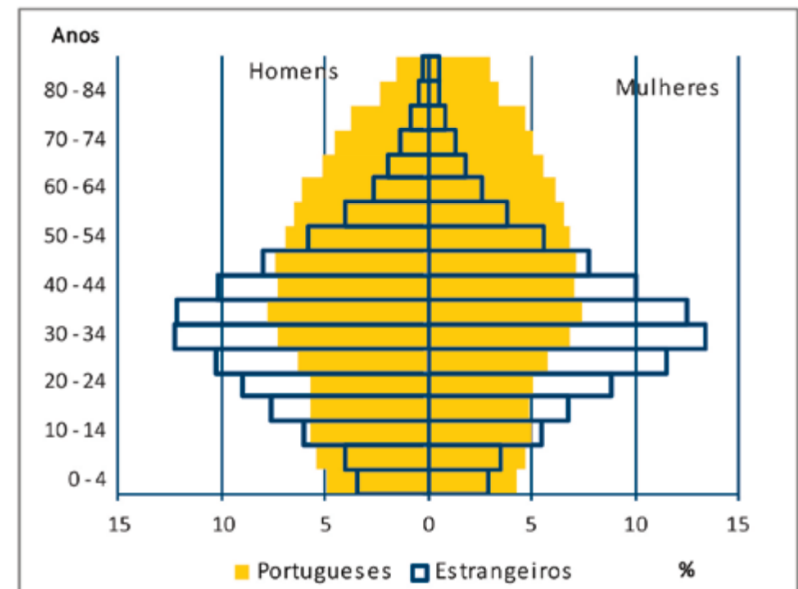

Migrants in Portugal

- Census 2011
 - 394.496 (~3,7% of population)
 - rising from 226.715 in 2001
 - Younger and with higher education than portuguese

Migrant Health in Portugal

- More occupational accidents
 - 13/100.000 Vs 7/100.000
- Better health perception (INS)
- Better health?
 - Diabetes, hipertension, mental health
 - Not standardized

Migrant's Access to Health in Portugal

- User fees
- **BUT**, mostly free (>60% of population)
 - Children, pregnant women, disabled, economic situation, etc...
- “People who request asylum and refugee, spouses or equivalent, direct descendants are relieved from paying fees, by presenting an asylum request or a residency authorization valid certificate”
